Can't make it to your polling station on 5th May 2016?



You can apply to vote by post or you can appoint someone to vote on your behalf (by proxy).

Alternatively, the person you have appointed to vote on your behalf can vote by post for you (postal proxy). In order to vote in one of these ways, you will need to complete an absent vote form which can be downloaded from our website at www.molevalley.gov.uk or by visiting www.aboutmyvote.co.uk. Please note that you can only vote by post or by proxy provided your registration has been confirmed under IER (Individual Electoral Registration).

Deadline for receiving:

Applications for registration*	Monday 18 April 2016
New postal vote and postal proxy applications, and for changes to existing postal or proxy votes	5pm on Tuesday 19 April 2016
New applications to vote by proxy (not postal proxy– see above)	5pm on Tuesday 26 April 2016

*Early registration is advised if you intend to vote by post to ensure that you receive your Postal Pack in good time.

The sooner you apply to register the better.
