1.0 BACKGROUND/INTRODUCTION

1.1 At the annual meeting of the Executive on 24th May 2011, Councillor Simon Ling was appointed for a three-year term of office as a representative on the Ashtead Peace Memorial Hall Committee.

1.2 The Executive has the power to make appointments to the various outside organisations throughout the municipal year.

1.3 Democratic Services were recently notified by the Secretary of the Ashtead Peace Memorial Hall that this appointment automatically ends in March 2014. Councillor Ling has agreed to be nominated as the Council's representative for a further three-year term of office, until 2017.

1.4 Renewal of the appointment for a further three years needs Executive agreement.
