MO/2019/0852/PLA: North Tower, Buckland Court Stables, Buckland Court, Reigate Road, Buckland, Betchworth, Surrey, RH3 7EA: Erection of roof and insertion of windows to tower. **MO/2019/0981/PLA: Wintershaw, Westcott Street, Westcott, Dorking, Surrey, RH4 3NU:** Drop kerb across pavement and hardstanding on land to front of house. **MO/2019/0991/PLA & 0992/LBC: 33, Wheelers Lane, Brockham, Betchworth, Surrey, RH3 7LA:** Construction of 4 No. dormer windows on southern roof elevation. **MO/2019/1012/CC: Kuoni House, Deepdene Avenue, Dorking, Surrey, RH5 4AZ:** Variation of Condition 2 of planning permission MO/2019/0103 for the erection of extensions to provide 4 No. new apartments at roof level together with elevational changes to the existing building and associated landscaping works, plus the transfer of land to the Council relating to the Deepdene Trail to allow an increase in the number of flats to 8. No. units. **MO/2019/1115/PLAH: Cop House, Old Road, Buckland, Betchworth, Surrey, RH3 7DY:** Erect single storey detached garage to front of property. **MO/2019/1140/PLAH: Cow Corner, Guildford Road, Abinger Hammer, Dorking, Surrey, RH5 6RY:** Conversion of a garage into two storey habitable accommodation ancillary to main house. **MO/2019/1156/PLAMAJ: Beaverbrook Golf Club, Reigate Road, Leatherhead, Surrey, KT22 8QX:** The provision of a new access route between the guest accommodation at Mickleham Downs and the former main drive (proposed to be resurfaced) with bollard lighting, the reinstatement of the former landscape features and other landscape improvements. **MO/2019/1178/PLAH: Club Cottage, White Horse Hotel, High Street, Dorking, Surrey, RH4 1BE:** Blocking up the covered porch area on south west elevation and re-shaping the double door opening on the south east elevation to form a single new front door entrance together with the construction of porch roof.
