### 1. Appointments to Outside Organisations

- 1.1 The Council makes appointments to outside organisations at the Annual meeting with the Executive making appointments during the municipal year.
- 1.2 MVDC have been informed that one of the three Council representatives for Dorking United Charities, Mrs Grieve, has decided to stand down. The Council’s other two representatives are Mr Heath and Mrs Lawrence.
- 1.3 The Leader of the Liberal Democrat Group has nominated Councillor Margaret Cooksey to fill the vacancy. Dorking United Charities have also indicated that they have another external candidate who would be willing to fill the vacancy in the event that a Councillor was not appointed.
- 1.4 The term of office runs until May 2018. The Executive is asked to decide the Council’s appointment to Dorking United Charities.
