Wrapping paper and cards

Please only buy and recycle wrapping paper and cards that are not lined with foil or plastic, don't have glitter on and don't contain batteries.

Cardboard

Flatten boxes to give you more space in your bin.

Christmas trees

Recycle them at a Christmas tree recycling point – details on molevalley.gov.uk.

Leaving bins out

Please leave bins on your property boundary by **6am**. Bins may be emptied at different times up until **4 pm**.

Missed collection

If your bin hasn't been emptied by 4pm, please report it at molevalley.gov.uk within 2 working days.

Rubbish bin

Collected fortnightly

- Plastic bags
- Black bin bags
- Crisp packets and wrappers
- Polystyrene
- Nappies
- Food and drink cartons
- Tissues and wipes
- Pizza boxes
- Coffee cups
- Plant pots and hard plastic

Textiles

Collected weekly. Can also be recycled at community recycling centres

Yes please

- Clothes
- Underwear
- Paired shoes
- Bags and belts

No thanks

- Pillows and duvets

Remember - Items must be clean, dry and in **no more than one small, tied carrier bag** placed next to your bin.

Small electricals

Collected weekly. Can also be recycled at community recycling centres.

Yes please

- Anything with a plug
- Anything battery-operated
- Batteries in a separate bag
- Chargers

No thanks

- Lightbulbs

Remember - Items must for into **one small, tied carrier bag** that is placed next to your bin. Batteries can be put into a separate small bag.

Food waste

Collected weekly from your separate food waste bin.

Yes please

- All food
- Meat
- Eggshells
- Teabags

No thanks

- Liquids

Remember - Reduce food waste by planning shops in advance, freezing food and using up leftovers. For more tips visit surreyep.org.uk

Garden waste

Collected fortnightly from your separate garden waste bin or can be recycled at community recycling centres.

Yes please

- Grass cuttings
- Prunings
- Fallen Leaves
- Cut Flowers

No thanks

- Soil and stones
